What is it? Day Camp is a fun-filled, action-packed summer activity for Cub Scouts entering first through fifth grade. This week-long, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. experience provides Scouts an opportunity to shoot bows and arrows and BB guns, swim, learn about nature, make crafts, play games, go fishing, and much more. Leaders and boys alike have a great time! All Scouts can earn belt loops and pins and Webelos can earn a variety of activity badges, including Aquanaut. Strap on your armor and saddle up your steed, because this year our theme is "Cubs of the Round Table!"

How do I register and how much does it cost? Scouts should register through their packs by filling out an application (available from their leader or online). The \$95 fee includes a T-shirt, cup, patch, snacks, crafts, and all the fun possible. Register by the May 18 early bird deadline and pay only \$85! (You'll also get an early bird patch!) Medical forms are required for all attending. Packs should try to collect and turn in their applications together, but individual applications are always accepted. Turn in your applications and fees at the council office or at the Jeffersonville Scout Shop.

When's the deadline? Applications are due in the council office or Scout Shop by May 18, or there's a \$20 late application fee.

What should Scouts bring? Scouts should bring a sack lunch and drink each day as well as rain gear, sunscreen, bug spray, swim trunks, and towel. Everything else is provided.

What about leader and parent participation?

Leaders and parents are encouraged to participate. Five-day adults receive a free T-shirt if their application is turned in on or before May 18. (Adults are always free.) Tiger Cubs (those entering first grade in Fall 2012) MUST have a parent at camp. Packs should arrange for some of their leaders and parents to attend.

What about younger children? A special "Pixie" area (a.k.a. Lil' Buddy Program) is available for younger (potty-trained) children of adults who are serving as den walkers and staff members. A nominal fee of \$20 covers the entire week. All registered pixies MUST have a parent or guardian on site at all times.
